



WALT DISNEY WORLD DINING GUIDE

When it comes to dining, Disney has you covered! From American favorites to truly adventurous cuisine, there is something for everyone. This is not a comprehensive list of all the dining options, but rather the tried and true fan favorites that are definitely worth considering on your vacation. Disney keeps an updated list of all the current dining locations on their website. If you have any additional questions about specific restaurants, do not hesitate to ask!

My BEST Disney Dining Tips:

- **Make dining reservations 180 days prior to your visit** - popular restaurants, like character dining experiences WILL book up! Make sure you're ready to make your advance dining reservations at 180 before check-in (or ASAP!)
- **Have a general idea of where you want to eat** - even for quick-service meals. Take a look at my detailed dining lists below to get some ideas.
- **Avoid the crowds by eating at off times** - simply put, if you can eat lunch at 11 AM or 1 PM, the crowds will be much less than at 12 PM. Same goes for the other meals.
- **Don't give up if there are no reservations available** - people cancel at the last minute all the time! Use the Disney app to see what reservations are available on the spot.
- **Book a character meal to bypass lines at the theme parks** - time is money in Disney World, and one valuable way to save time is by booking character meals. YES, they can be costly, but if meeting characters is high on your or your child's list, I'd HIGHLY recommend attending at least one character dining experience.
- **Book your meal during Happily Ever After Firework Show** for spectacular views. - Watching the fireworks from INSIDE Cinderella's castle? Magical. Other awesome dining locations for watching include California Grill at the Contemporary and Narcoossee's at the Grand Floridan Resort.
- **Get groceries delivered to your hotel room** with Garden Grocer, or even Amazon!
- **Book a Club level resort room** and get free continental breakfast, drinks, wine/alcohol, desserts, and hors d'oeuvres - there's no harm in living like a king and queen.
- **Use dining plan credits on more expensive menu items** to get a better value! For instance, if you have an entree and your choices are chicken at \$20 or the filet mignon for \$35, but both are 1 credit, the filet is a MUCH better value for that credit.
- **Choose a buffet if you've got picky eaters**, or different tastes in a family.
- **If you have food allergies, alert the restaurant that you have special dietary needs** - Disney restaurants are very accommodating.
- **Order a cake to celebrate a special occasion.** Let me know if you'd like me to set this up for you!
- **Cancel your dining reservations 24 hours in advance** or before 11:59 est the day before your meal to avoid being charged a cancellation fee.
- **Invest in the Disney Dining Plan if you know that you and your family are big eaters** - this makes sense for families who enjoy sit-down dining and experiences like character dining and shows.
- **Snack Credits on Dining Plan are worth \$5+** - so make the most of it! Starbucks coffee is a great use of credit.
- **Gratuity is not included in the dining plan, FYI.**

Quick-Service Locations

<i>Aloha Isle</i>	World-famous Dole Whip is served here in cups and floats! It's a classic Disney treat.	S
<i>Be Our Guest</i>	Be Our Guest is a must for any Beauty and the Beast lover! Set in the Beast's castle, there are three wings with different scenes! During breakfast and lunch BOG is a quick service meal, but you still need a reservation to eat here. You'll find egg sandwiches, cheese and meat plates, and pastries for breakfast. The lunch menu includes French onion soup, braised pork, and French dip sandwiches. The Beast won't make an appearance during quick service times but make sure to try the gray stuff - it's delicious - on top of a chocolate cupcake!	B, L
<i>Columbia Harbor House</i>	Delicious food that will fill you up! Our favorites are the shrimp and lobster rolls, but I don't know a kid who wouldn't like the chicken tenders! Insider tip: head upstairs to find more tables and a bathroom; a quiet place to enjoy a break!	L, D
<i>Gaston's Tavern</i>	Know for cinnamon rolls the size of your head and LeFou's Brew....it's signature non-alcoholic drink, Gaston's Tavern is a rustic snack stop. Look for Gaston pumping his muscles close by...	S
<i>Pecos Bill Tall Tale Inn & Cafe</i>	Stop by this Western saloon and grab some south of the border grub - like fajitas, taco bowls, and a southwest burger (be sure to top it mile-high with toppings from the toppings bar).	L, D
<i>Plaza Ice Cream Parlor</i>	Nostalgic classic ice cream parlor on Main Street offering hand-dipped cones and waffles with ice cream in the morning (it's ok to eat ice cream for breakfast at Disney!).	S
<i>Sleepy Hollow</i>	A small shop located in the shadow of the castle in Liberty Square, Sleepy Hollow serves up some of the best snacks and sandwiches in the Magic Kingdom! Waffle sandwiches, ice cream, and funnel cakes make this a delicious pit stop.	L, D, S
<i>Cosmic Rays</i>	A classic burger and fries joint located near Tomorrowland, with a toppings bar! You'll also find salads, chicken nuggets, and sloppy joes. A big positive is that there is a ton of indoor seating for those ultra-hot days where you want to get into the air and cool down.	L, D

<i>Be Our Guest</i>	BOG restaurant is a table service location for dinner service, and you will also meet the Beast at dinner! The French cuisine is delicious and this is the only dining location in Magic Kingdom where you will find alcohol.	D  *2 credits
<i>Cinderella's Royal Table</i>	Dine inside the castle and meet Cinderella herself! Peek at the park from the stained-glass windows, or if you're lucky enough to snag the perfect reservation time, watch the fireworks while you eat! This location books up fast, and can be more expensive than other dining options.	B, L, D  *2 credits
<i>The Crystal Palace</i>	Meet Pooh and friends at an all-you-can-eat dining experience located right off Main Street USA.	B, L, D 
<i>Liberty Tree Tavern</i>	Thanksgiving-style food served family-style; filling and delicious!	L, D
<i>Skipper's Canteen</i>	Heavily themed dining located in Adventureland, near the Jungle Cruise. For those who have a more adventurous palate, this may be the spot for you!	L, D

Quick-Service Locations

<i>Kabuki Cafe - Japan</i>	Japanese shaved ice and sushi! No indoor seating but plenty of seating nearby within the World Showcase.	L, D, S
<i>Katsura Grill – Japan</i>	Don't miss this location hidden away in Japan. It features noodle dishes, pre-made sushi, and other entrees such as garlic shrimp, teriyaki, and a chicken cutlet curry.	L, D, S
<i>Kringla Bakeri Og Kafe - Norway</i>	This quaint bakery in the Norway pavilion serves delicious treats like pretzels, sweet soft-bread and it's specialty, School Bread, a sweet custard donut dipped in coconut.	L, S
<i>La Cantina de San Angel – Mexico</i>	Enjoy a Mexican meal beside the waterfront of World Showcase Lagoon. Popular favorites here are tacos of all varieties and kids will love the nachos. Don't forget to try one of the delicious margarita varieties here.	L, D, S
<i>Les Halles Boulangerie Patisserie</i>	Located in the back of the French pavilion, you'll find this delicious gem of a bakery full of freshly baked bread, sandwiches, soup, and pastries! Seating can be limited but grab your meal and find a spot outside on the patio. They open at 9AM (two hours before the World Showcase) so it can be a nice escape from the crowds for a breakfast. <i>Refreshment Port - near Canada</i>	Signature Poutine, fries covered with cheese and gravy, are a perfect snack. Grab a Croissant Donut while you're here, you'll thank me later.	S
<i>Sunshine Seasons</i>	Cafeteria-style quick service location with tons of options for everyone in your party. American and Asian flavors offered.	B, L, D
<i>Tangierine Cafe – Morocco</i>	Adventurous eaters, as well as vegetarians, will delight at this dining location at the Morocco pavilion. You'll find platters of falafel, hummus, lentil salad, schwarma of all varieties .	L, D, S
<i>Tutto Gusto Wine Cellar</i>	Wine lover's will rejoice at this lounge that features small plates of authentic Italian cuisine and a huge selection of wine, beer, and other drinks. NOTE: It is not on the dining plan.	L, S *no dining plan

<i>Akershus Royal Banquet Hall</i>	A dream come true for any princess or prince. Dine in a medieval castle and meet Cinderella, Snow White, Sleeping Beauty and more! This meal is an all-you-can-eat buffet located in the World Showcase of Epcot.	B, L, D 
<i>Beirgarten - Germany</i>	All-you-can-eat German buffet served family style while live entertainment plays from the stage. The Grapefruit Beer is a fan favorite!	L, D
<i>Garden Grill</i>	This fun restaurant actually (very slowly) spins while you eat to give you views of the attraction 'Living With the Land'. Mickey, Chip and Dale, and other characters, stop by while you eat. Try the sticky buns that are served with breakfast - they're amazing, warm, and endless!	B, L, D 
<i>Le Cellier - Canada</i>	They are known for their delicious cheese soup and pretzels, and filet mignon. This Canadian Steakhouse in the World Showcase is a great date night out.	L, D *2 credits
<i>Monsieur Paul - France</i>	This upscale restaurant that features French cuisine is located upstairs, above Chefs de France. It is definitely spendy, offering Prix fixe menu starting at around \$89 per person - but I don't think you'll be disappointed! Authentic French meals served in a beautiful atmosphere, it's perfect for a special night out.	D
<i>Rose and Crown Pub - England</i>	Fish N' Chips and Beer, what's not to love? It's a classic English pub.	L, D
<i>Teppan Edo - Japan</i>	Hibachi-style food prep creates fun entertainment and a yummy meal.	L, D
<i>Via Napoli - Italy</i>	Stop by for authentic Italian fare. The pizza is wonderful!	L, D

<i>Woody's Lunch Box</i>	Brand new Quick Service location in Toy Story Land! The menu looks tasty. S'mores French Toast Sandwich, Grilled Cheese, and BBQ Brisket are some of the offerings.	B, L, D
<i>Dockside Diner</i>	Check out this cute walk-up 1950's steamer boat! They serve breakfast sandwiches, foot-long hot dogs, and BBQ sandwiches. Outdoor seating only, but it overlooks Echo Lake.	B, L, D

<i>50's Prime Time Cafe</i>	Good home-cooking, just like Mama made! You'll feel like you're stepping back in time into a 1950's kitchen. They're known for their fried chicken, pot roast, and milkshakes! You may even get a playful server who makes you keep your elbows off the table and clean your plate!	L, D
<i>Hollywood-Brown Derby</i>	Great signature dining, the Cobb salad is a Disney favorite. A fantastic choice for more mature palates. Can be pricey but often easier to obtain a reservation here. Dine with an Imagineer takes place here.	L, D *2 credits
<i>Hollywood and Vine</i>	Character Dining at an all-you-can-eat buffet. Depending on the meal and season, Disney Junior characters or Mickey, Minnie, and the gang greet you during your meal.	L, D 
<i>Sci-Fi Dine-in Theater</i>	Burgers and milkshakes while you sit in "car-shaped" booths and watch movies at this Drive-In Theater inspired restaurant.	L, D

ANIMAL KINGDOM

Quick-Service Locations

<i>Flame Tree BBQ</i>	You can't miss the wafting smells of delicious BBQ from Flame Tree! Generous portions of salads, ribs, chicken, and pulled pork make this a great lunch stop.	L, D
<i>Harambe Market</i>	Located in the back portion of the African section, this open-air marketplace offers a wide variety of grilled items like chicken, sausages, and beef kabobs with flatbread.	L, D, S
<i>Pizzafari</i>	Pizza is just 'meh' and seating is completely outdoors. I'd pass unless your kids will only eat pizza!	L, D, S
<i>Satu'li Canteen</i>	Disney totally stepped up it's quick-service game with the opening of Satu'li Canteen inside the Pandora area at Animal Kingdom. The food looks like it's from another planet, and the taste is out of this world, too. You'll find things like chicken, shrimp, and beef with sides of beans, noodles, or salad. The presentation is gorgeous and the atmosphere is incredible. Highly recommended.	L, D, S
<i>Yak & Yeti Local Food Cafe</i>	Asian Beef Noodle Bowls, Fried Rice and Egg Rolls - this walk-up counter serves tasty meals in the Asia section of Animal Kingdom.	B, L, D

<i>Tusker House</i>	Buffet service with traditional and African-style offerings. Classic Disney characters greet you throughout your meal wearing their safari gear. It's a very popular reservation, make sure to book early.	B, L, D 
<i>Tiffins</i>	Full service dining with a delicious and interesting menu. Some options include Alaskan Halibut, Raman, and Wagyu Eye of Ribeye. The adventurous may even try out the octopus on the appetizer menu!	L, D *2 credits
<i>Yak & Yeti</i>	This is the table service version of Yak & Yeti which offers a nice refuge from the heat and crowds. The restaurant is highly-themed with Asian-inspired goods. You'll find Lo Mein dishes, Korean Beef, Sweet and Sour Chicken and Kobe Beef Burgers, among other selections, on the menu.	L, D

RESORT-AREA DINING

These **table-service dining** locations are seated within (or nearby to) the Disney resort complexes, so no park ticket is required to dine. Resort-area dining is a great choice for a rest day or the perfect ending to a busy day at the parks. It's also a fun way to explore the different resorts! I did not include quick service meals in this list, as there are just too many to list as all Disney resorts have at least one quick-service dining location.

<i>Boma</i>	Animal Kingdom Lodge - Jambo House	The perfect buffet for an adventurous family, Boma is a combination of the many delicious flavors of Africa, along with many of the common buffet foods like mac n' cheese and chicken nuggets.	B, D
<i>Jiko</i>	Animal Kingdom Lodge - Jambo House	Located in the main building of the Animal Kingdom Lodge, Jiko is hidden away and lavishly themed. Delicious blend of traditional African, Indian and Mediterranean cuisine are served up with the largest African wine selection located outside of Africa.	D *2 credits
<i>Sanaa</i>	Animal Kingdom Lodge - Kidani Village	If your family loves to try new flavors and adventurous dishes, Sanaa is the place for you! Start with the flatbread service with 9 different dipping sauces to try. Entrées include various meat, seafood and vegetarian options that feature different spices and flavors of East Africa.	B, L, D
<i>Cape May Cafe</i>	Beach Club Resort	Meet Mickey and the gang ready to set sail at this Nautical New-England themed breakfast buffet. Characters do not visit at dinner, but be sure to try the all-you-can-eat seafood buffet which offers crab legs, shrimp, mussels, clams, chicken, ribs, and more!	B, D 
<i>Trattoria al Forno</i>	Boardwalk Area	Join Rapunzel, Flynn Rider, Ariel, and Prince Eric at the Bon Voyage Adventure Breakfast - choose from fritatta, buttermilk pancakes, breakfast meats, pastries and more. Try the specialty Italian coffee! For dinner, they serve traditional Italian meals. Characters present only at breakfast.	B, D

<i>Yachtsman Steakhouse</i>	Yacht Club Resort	Enjoy a perfectly-cooked steak in a New-England nautical atmosphere - the Yachtsman Steakhouse makes a perfect date night! Start off the meal with their legendary garlic bread service, and pair your steak with delectable truffle mac n' cheese! For non-steak eaters, they also offer chicken, pasta, and seafood choices. <i>Sprinkles</i>	Town Center	I had to add Sprinkles bakery to the list because their cupcakes (and cupcake sundaes) are too good to be missed! Unique and traditional flavors are baked daily. They even have a cupcake ATM to quench those late-night cravings.	S
<i>Wolfgang Puck Express</i>	Marketplace	French toast or breakfast pizza served up in the morning, or come back for Artisan specialty pizzas and sandwiches for lunch or dinner. A great value, especially for those on the dining plan, because the pizzas are large enough to share!	B, L, D
